



Goodwill Industries Serving Southeast Nebraska, Inc. (Goodwill Lincoln)

Goodwill Industries in Lincoln is a non-profit organization that maintains an effective Employment Services Program that offers job training and employment programs to people who face barriers to employment. Goodwill's client population includes people with physical, mental, and emotional disabilities, or dependence on public support. The sale of donated goods in their retail locations remains the greatest source of funding for programs Goodwill provides. In 2022, Goodwill diverted 2.2 million pounds from the local landfill and helped over 4,000 individuals with employment-related services.
