Personally Identifiable Information. At our Site, we do not collect personally identifiable information from individuals unless they provide it to us voluntarily and knowingly. Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska only gathers personally identifiable data on our Site, such as names, addresses, Zip/postal codes, e-mail addresses, etc., when voluntarily submitted by a visitor. Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska may automatically collect certain technical information from your computer such as your Internet service provider, your Internet Protocol address, your browser type, your operating system, the pages viewed, the pages viewed immediately before and after accessing the Site, and the search terms entered to get to our Site. This information allows us to improve and customize our services. We and our service providers may collect this information using "cookies," which are small text files that many sites save on your computer, or similar technologies. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska is committed to providing a safe, secure, and fun online experience for children who visit our Site. We are dedicated to safeguarding any personally identifiable information collected online and to helping parents and children have positive experiences on the Internet.

We will never knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 13 ("Children") without prior verifiable parental consent. With parental consent, we may collect information from Children, such as: name, address, email address, account information, and user generated content. This information allows us to fulfill a requested transaction and facilitate participation in online programs, keep records, undertake certain marketing activities, or to otherwise customize or enhance the Site experience for Children. We will not require a Child to disclose more information than is reasonably necessary to participate in a Site activity. The sharing of personally

identifiable information of Children with third parties will be done in accord with the above section Use and Sharing of Personally Identifiable Information.

USE OF COOKIES AND SIMILAR TECHNOLOGIES
