Step one: Bookmarks

Create a corner bookmark: Girls will color a premade bookmark or get creative and make their own design.

Step two: How to treat books.

For this activity the girls will do any activity to understand how to treat book in and library and at home.

Step three: Scavenger hunt.

Girls will do a scavenger hunt around the local library and learn where different books are located.

Step four: Play a story related game and have a snack too!

One idea would be to play give the mouse a cookie based on the book "If You Give a Mouse a Cookie". One girl will be blindfolded, and their peers will lead them to the mouse as they try to put the cookie in its hand. Then have a cookie snack!

Step five: Write your own story.

Girl Scouts will write their own stories with fun characters, setting, and plot by using sequence a story pictures to create a story, then share with the group!
