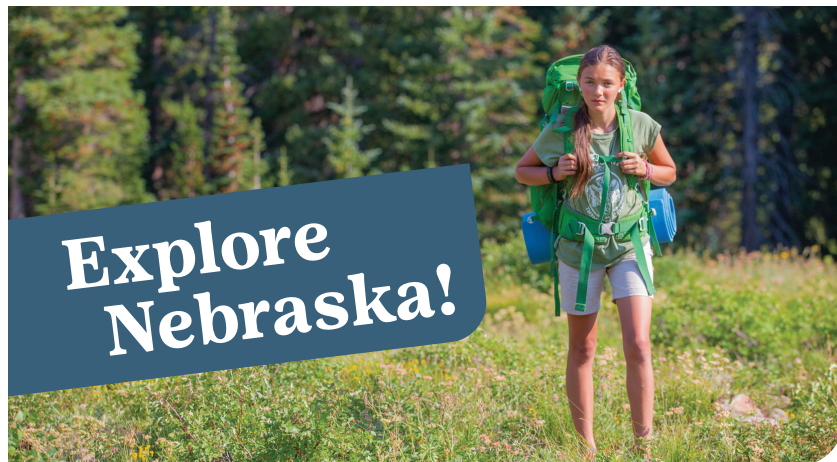




Girl Scouts Love State Parks

A **Nebraska State Park Sticker** is required on all vehicles entering a state park, state historical park or recreation area. They can be purchased online at OutdoorNebraska.gov at a park kiosk or administration building.

Please **dress appropriately** for activities and the weather. Longer pants and close-toed shoes are recommended for hiking. Bring a **water bottle, bug spray, sun protection** and a **sense of adventure!**
